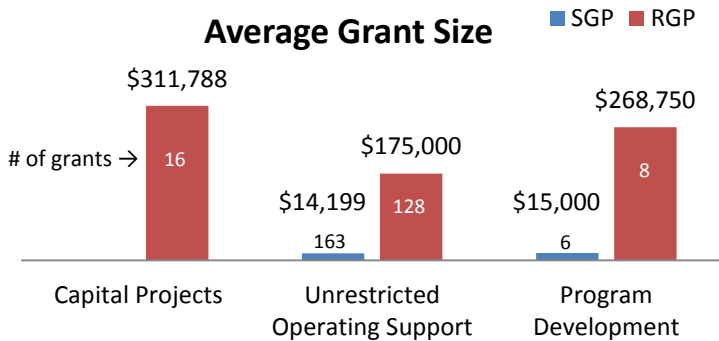


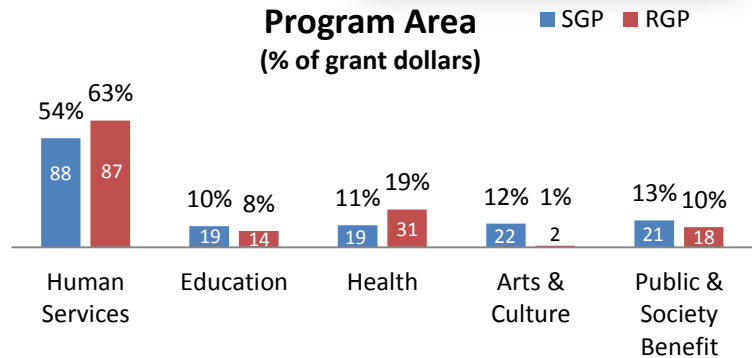
*Our mission is to build a better Southern California by supporting nonprofit organizations to more effectively serve the underserved.*

In FY 2016, the Foundation made **320** grants totaling **\$31.4M** through the Regular and Small Grant Programs (RGP and SGP). Of these, **77%** were **Unrestricted Operating Support** grants primarily supporting efforts to strengthen grantee infrastructure for fund development and diversification, board and staff development, and service delivery and expansion. In addition to our responsive grantmaking, the Foundation made **9** Foundation Initiatives grants totaling **\$3.8M**.
